

An efficient way to learn a language is to try to recall vocab words and expressions that you have seen earlier in class. Follow the strategy below when you complete your homework to become a better learner.

## **Strategy:**

- 1. **Read** through all the sentences (1-10) and the reminders.
- 2. Before writing anything down, **highlight** the keywords you can't recall from memory.
- 3. Look through your book to **find** them and write them down on a piece of paper.
- 4. **Look up** any other words you couldn't find using an online dictionary.
- 5. Hide the piece of paper and write down the translation for the sentences.
- 6. Always try to **challenge yourself** and complete the two flags or three flags activities if you can.
- 7. **Check** your work carefully using your draft paper and your book and correct your spelling if necessary.

## **Reminders:**

- Don't forget that adjectives have different forms depending on the gender of the noun!
